



Kitchen Sink Care Guide

Meir sinks are hand-made, using premium 304-grade stainless steel, and finished in an environmentally friendly PVD coating with an additional nanotechnology layer of fine aggregate which provides a durability unlike anything witnessed before.

The nanotechnology allows the sinks to withstand daily use, yet no household material is completely invulnerable to scratching. We have engineered our sinks with sound-absorbing technology, an easy-to-install design, and matching wastes (included with every sink) for peace of mind. The hand-crafted internal edges have been rounded and surface edging has been compressed for a slimline look which also assists in avoiding grime and residue build-up over time

Regular maintenance is required with non-abrasive cleaners
Here are some Do's and Don'ts, which will extend the life of your sink:

Do:

- Use non-abrasive cleaning wipes and chemicals
- Wipe away chemicals or cleaning agents when the sink is not being used
- Avoid water spots by keeping your sink dry with a soft towel or dry cloth
- Use a sink grid to help protect your sink from scratching (available from any stockist)
- Use a premium metal cleaner where required and follow the correct usage instructions
 - Use a vinegar and water solution to help remove deposits or build-up
 - Avoid dropping sharp objects or heavy items directly on the sink surface

Do not:

- Use any harsh chemicals such as chlorine or acid-based chemicals
 - Use your sink as a cutting board
- Leave soaking wet sponges in/on your sink for more than a few minutes
 - Use harsh cleaning materials or abrasive items such as steel wool
- Attempt or conduct any repairs or alterations to the product without written approval from Meir
 - Pour paint or any other similar chemical or material into your sink
 - Install or use in a laundry
